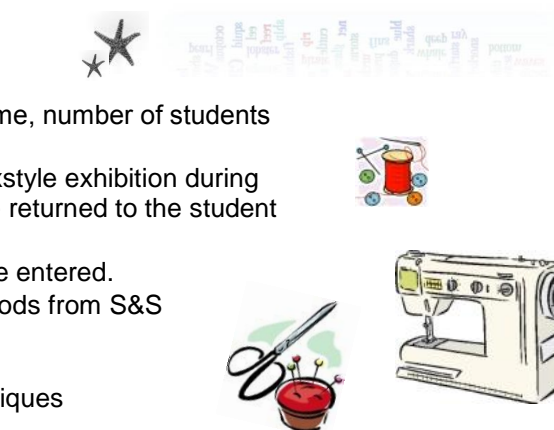
- Name of school, address, teacher's name, number of students participating in the challenge
